For the fourth time in a row, Fenix Outdoor International has disclosed non-financial data and reported those under the framework of the Global Reporting Initiative's G4 criteria set as well as according to the German Sustainability Code, a framework, likely to be a blueprint for the new EU legislative reporting requirement, and the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact.

For the first time, selected data were checked and evaluated by Ernst and Young, one of the four leading global accounting firms. E&Y was not only positive about the data quality but also about the honesty and holistic involvement of different departments in the data gathering exercise.
